

Day 1 Depart for Mysore by road (139 Kms/3 hrs). Enroute visit Srirangapatna & Daria Daulat Bagh. The fortress,16km from mysore, stands in the middle of an island between two tributaries of the cauvery river and was once the capital of hyder ali and tipu sulthan. See tipu sultans mosque with its twin minarets and dungeons where british officers were once imprisoned, inside the fortress.



Arrive Mysore and transfer to your Hotel .Late in the afternoon, Visit Chamundi Hills & Mysore Palace , Which is treasure house of exquisite carvings and works of art from all over the world, followed by St Philomen Church & Devaraj Market :
