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Shimla

(3 Nights 4 Days)

Day 1 – ARRIVE CHANDIGARH AND TRANSFER TO SHIMLA (D)

Today after arrival, Transfer to Shimla by Road (112 Kms- 3 Hrs), Enjoy the Valley view of Shimla on the way.

After arrival , Check inn Hotel and Relax , Later in the afternoon , get ready for a Shimla sightseeing tour which includes visit to places like Indian Institute of Advanced Study, Kali Bari Temple, Lakkar Bazar, Mall Rod, and Christ Church.

Take the remainder of the day to shop and eat your way through the Mall Road and Lakkar Bazaar. Later, return to the hotel for a scrumptious dinner and overnight stay.



Day 2 – FULL DAY KUFRI

Today After your breakfast , get ready for a sightseeing tour of Kufri. On your drive to Kufri, enjoy the lush expanses of the famous Green Valley. Kufri is an ideal retreat with attractions such as Mini Zoo, Fun World Campus, and Mahasu Peak.
