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Day3: Leh-Nubra-Leh with Sumoor(2 Days) Day 2 of 2 - AfterBreakfast, check out from the camps & visit Diskit Monastery, Hot Water Springs, Panamik via confluence of Shyok & Nubra River across Sumoor. Return to Leh by Evening. Overnight stay at Leh.

Day4: Leh-Pangong-Leh Day Trip - After early Breakfast proceed for one of the most beautiful & scenic, Salt water Pangong Lake at Spangmik via Changla Pass (17350 ft). Various Bollywood movies have been shot at this lake. One-Third of this lake is controlled by India & rest of the two-third lies under Chinese province.
